- 1. Generation Schools accepts children from the age of 18 Months in the 0-3 Year Phase.
- 2. The 12-15 Year Phases refers to students in Lower Secondary 1, 2 and 3 or grade 7, 8 and 9.
- 3. The 15-18 Year Phases refers to students in IGCSE, AS/A levels, IEB (Grade 10-12) and/or Sí.
- 4. Students commencing Grade 10 or their International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), regardless of age, will be included in the 15-Exit Year Phases for academic and billing purposes.
- Annual Innings/Outings fees for 9-Exit Year Phases are for terms 1 to 3. A camp is organised during the year at an additional cost.
- All annual levies i.e. Annual Resource Levy*, Annual Inning/Outing Levy**, Annual Art Levy*** (if applicable) and Annual Sciences Levy*** (if applicable) are payable by 01/01/2022.
- Annual Art and Sciences levies are required in the 12-15 Year Phase due to the introduction and readiness strategy for IGCSE subjects outcomes- which include Art and Design, Physical Science, Chemistry, Physics and Biology.
- In the 15-Exit Year Phases, the Annual Art and Design Levy is required if this subject is elected for IGCSE, AS/A Level or IEB. The Sciences Levy is required for each of the following subjects if elected for either Cambridge or IEB:
 - Physical Sciences [IGCSE]
 - Chemistry [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
 - Physics [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
 - Biology [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
- 9. All costs related to coursework components related to Cambridge [IGCSE and AS/A Level] Travel and Tourism, Environmental Management and Global Perspectives are to be incurred by students, with the exception of Art and Design which has a related annual levy. This will allow students to pursue their own course work approach.
- 10. Textbooks for all phases are excluded from fees.
- 11. All students from 12-Exit Year Phases will be required to purchase a device or bring their own device. Regardless of which option is chosen the device's administration rights are required to be signed over to the school for management purposes. Devices are brought to school at own risk. Device specifications will be provided.
- 12. School fees are calculated on an annual basis and are charged monthly over a 12 month period, with the exception of final year 15-Exit Year Phase students (i.e. last academic year in this phase). These particular 15-Exit Year Phase students will be charged the annual fees over 10 months, and not 12 months.
- 13. All fees are payable in advance. Monthly school fees are to be received by the school on or before 1st of each month. Annual levies are to be received by the school on or before 01/01/2022. Payments are required to be gross of payment gateway transaction costs. Should a debit order be rejected due to insufficient funds or other reasons, the guardians will be liable for associated transaction charges.
- 14. Free holiday care if you are a Full Day student.
- 15. Early morning care is billed irrespective of the amount of days attended in a particular month.
- 16. Lunch is compulsory for 9-Exit Year Phases. Food prepared on campus is aligned to our nutrition policy.
- 17. Lunch options include normal, vegan, gluten-free, dairy-free or vegetarian. Where applicable, school fees are displayed using the normal lunch fee option.
- Special Dietary Requirements for Morning Snack and/or Lunch and/or Afternoon Snack is an additional fee per month i.e. Vegan, Gluten-free, Dairy-free or Vegetarian, regardless of which billing option is chosen.
- 19. Monthly school fees are payable via Debit Order only. Debit orders are required to be set for the first banking day of each month. Parents are required to complete, sign and return the Debit Order Mandate Form to the School and submit a copy to accounts@generationschools.co.za

- 20. Fees received after the 1st of each month will be subject to a late penalty fee of R500 per month and interest on outstanding balances will be charged at Prime + 2%, per month. Should fees be outstanding in full or part for one or more months the child/children may be suspended from school. Should fees be outstanding in full or part for two or more months the outstanding account may be handed over to debt recovery attorneys.
- 21. One school term's notice, in writing, is required before removing your child/ren from the school, or payment in lieu thereof will be required.
- 22. One school term's notice, in writing, is required before cancelling your child/ren from all school transport, or payment in lieu thereof will be required.
- 23. One school term's notice, in writing, is required before removing your child/ren from boarding, or payment in lieu thereof will be required.
- 24. Parents can change their billing options on the Generation Schools Parent Portal. One calendar month notice is required in order to change billing options i.e. Full day to Half day Excl./Incl. lunch.
- 25. Fees exclude external examinations e.g. Cambridge Checkpoints, IGCSE, AS, A levels, IEB costs, Si costs as well as camps, textbooks, therapists, remedial specialists, facilitators, invigilators, calculators, IT devices, workshops (parent and/or student), uniforms (school and sport), elective extra-mural activities, career advisement assessments, bus transport and boarding, if applicable.
- 26. Sibling discounts are not applicable.
- 27. Please quote your 'Child Name and Surname' with your school fee payments.
- 28. Sports, Arts, Cultural and Extra-Mural Activities may only be offered to certain phases- please inquire from the school for further information.
- 29. Boarding fees relating to 5 or 7 weekday boarders are required to be paid in advance or over ten monthly payments (not twelve) if made via debit order, to be debited on the first banking day of each month. Laundry fees are compulsory and are included in boarder fees.
- 30. Foreign exchange students are required to pay registration, placement, school fees, levies, transport, boarding and any other applicable service fees termly in advance. Early settlement discounts are not applicable.
- * All stationery requirements are provided for the student by the school.
- ** Innings/Outings from the 0-3 Phase to 6-9 Phase take place termly.
- *** Art and Design [IGCSE or AS/A Level], Physical Sciences [IGCSE], Biology [IGCSE or AS/A Level], Chemistry [AS/A Level] and Physics [AS/A Level] are standalone subjects. Therefore, the Levies for each subject election cover all required supplies, materials and resources for the entire curriculum for the academic year.
