

FET CERTIFICATE IN SPORTS ADMINISTRATION FACT SHEET



1. OVERVIEW

The FET Certificate in Sports Administration is designed for students to acquire various skills and tools to conceptualise, plan, organise and innovate within the sports industry, be that in schools, communities or business settings.

This programme also promotes wellness, making it real and going beyond theoretical content alone as it incorporates practical application. Students plan and implement various well-balanced sports and fitness plans to contribute to the community and the sports industry itself.

The FET Sports Administration qualification provides the students with a matric equivalence NQF 4 certificate. It is an access qualification which will grant you access to a Bachelor of Sport Administration or Higher Certificate options.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students should have completed grade 11, the Cambridge International IGCSE or the equivalent.

3. DURATION

The programme is designed to be completed in one academic year.

4. OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this course are to provide participants with:

- Theoretical knowledge and practical skills in sports administration;
- An understanding of the business side of the sport, including management, marketing, and event planning;
- The ability to apply sports science principles to enhance athlete performance; and
- The opportunity to gain work experience in the sports industry.

5. PROGRAMME MANAGEMENT

Students complete components in Sports Administration, English HL, Afrikaans 1st Add, Mathematical Literacy.

3. Practical application facilitated and assessed by our dedicated and qualified staff.
4. Organised gym sessions with facilitator support.

7. Internship opportunities and workplace experience with CV references.

6. ASSESSMENT

This programme is assessed through graded assignments, including continuous theory and practical application assessments.
